It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total depth of approximately 3850' with rotary tools in order to develop indicated oil reserves. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 8 5/8" to be set at 1675' and cemented with approximately 800 sacks, cement to be circulated. 5 1/2" to be set at 3850' and cemented with approximately 1100 sacks and to be perforated opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.
