FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was completed on March 2nd, 1937, at a total depth of 3950' in Pink Lime. The 7" OD production string was set at 3810' and cemented with 275 sacks, casing off several good shows of gas in several horizons between 3320' and 3700'. Since the time of completion the well has gone to making large volumes of water and more gas will be necessary to continue flowing the well. We propose to gun perforate the gas section and later acidize the perforated section, if necessary.
