FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was completed 12-1-38 to a total depth of 3874' as an oil well producing from the Queen and Grayburg formation, open hole interval 3860-74'. In September 1956 a retainer plug was set at 3715' w/250 sx and plugged back as a Jalmat Gas Well producing from perforated interval 3145-3255' from the Yates formation.

We propose to run 2 1/2" TBG w/treating PKR set at 3310', perforate Seven Rivers 3390-3412' and 3436-52', sandfrac w/10,000 gals crude, 10,000 lbs sand, 500 lbs Adomite spearheaded w/1000 gals 15% LSTNE acid, pull 2 1/2" TBG w/treating PKR, run 2" TBG set at 3300' and return well to production.
