Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of Form C-104 on your J. K. Rector #1-A G, Sec. 31-21S-36E which it will be necessary to hold for additional information. The S/2 and the NW/4 of Section 31 are in the South Eunice pool, which produces from the 7 Rivers formation. The NE/4 of Section 31 is in the Eunice pool, which produces from the Queen, Grayburg, and San Andres formations. Your C-104 identifies the formation from which the well is producing only as "sand". It will be necessary for you, therefore, to identify the producing formation by letter. If it is the 7 Rivers an extension of the South Eunice pool will be required.
