Gentlemen:

In a letter dated June 13, 1957, Mr. R. F. Montgomery, Proration Manager, notified The Texas Company that it would be necessary to obtain a No Flare Order not later than August 14, 1957, for its J. K. Rector Well No. 5, Section 31, Township 21, Range 36, Eumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, in order to comply with the provisions contained in Order R-553.

The August Proration Schedule indicates a daily oil allowable of 38 barrels with a gas-oil ratio of 410 cubic feet per barrel, or 15.5 MCF of gas per day being flared.

The Texas Company has an agreement with Phillips Petroleum Company to add this well's gas to an existing contract already in effect for other wells it has in the vicinity of this well. We feel that the well will be connected to Phillips' casinghead gas gathering system within the next few weeks and respectfully request a 60-day temporary exception to the No Flare Order R-553.

Attached is a plat showing the well location, tank battery location, offset ownership, and the location of Phillips' six-inch gas gathering line.
