FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

State "D" Well No. 4 is a marginal well with a GOR of 13,125. The limiting GOR for wells in the Bumont Pool is 10,000. It is proposed to clean-out to TD of 3990'; run radioactive logs; run 2" tubing open ended and acidize with 500 gallon mud acid and wash to clean up; sandfracture open hole section with 15000 gal. and 15000# sand down tubing and casing.

This remedial procedure was followed on State "D" Wells 1 and 2 and production was increased materially. These wells were restored to top allowable status and natural flow. Prior to remedial work they were marginal and it was necessary to produce by gas lift.

It is believed that the proposed remedial work will restore this well to top allowable status.
