and around 2-3/8" tubing at 3637'. Cut off 2-3/8" tubing with chemical cutter at 3635'. POH. Ran 3 joints of 4-3/4" wash pipe, mill skirt and T-Dog fishing tool on 2-3/8" tubing to 3637', and reversed sand, RCNB sealers and metal from frac charts off Baker retrievable BP. Pulled 2-3/8" tubing, wash pipe and BP. Cleaned out frac sand with 3-1/2" bailer from 3841' to 3875'. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and Baker Model "C" PB packer, parallel anchor and 2-1/16" tubing (long string) and set in tension with 11,000#. Ran stinger sub on 2-1/16" tubing (short string) and set in tension with 6000#. Installed well head. Ran rods and pump in South Amice. Placed both zones on production.
