My Shell-State No. 1 well on the subject lease produces oil and gas from the South Eunice Pool. I have requested Phillips Petroleum Company, owner of the nearest casinghead gas line connection, to make connection for purchase of the gas produced from this lease. Phillips tested twice and each time orally related to me that the well makes "about 29,000 cubic feet of gas per day". That company declined to make the connection that would be necessary to the sale of this gas.

This letter is to respectfully request that the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico issue a No-Flare Exception order for the subject lease and well.

I enclose a copy of the Phillips letter that came after I requested written reply to my plea for gathering line connection and a plat showing the locations of my well, tank battery, heater-treater and the nearest gathering line connection site.
