Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests an exception to Rule 5(A) of Order R-1670 for approval of a 320-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit covering the N/2 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Bumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. This Non-Standard Unit will be attributed to the Arnott-Ramsay (NCT-D) Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the west line of Section 33.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Applicant's Arnott-Ramsay (NCT-D) Well No. 3 is now assigned a 480-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit covering the N/2 and SW/4 of Section 33.
- (2) Applicant desires to reduce the acreage attributed to this well to 320 acres covering the N/2 of Section 33.
- (3) The Non-Standard Unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- (4) The Non-Standard Unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (5) The entire Non-Standard Unit may reasonably be presumed to be gas productive in the Bumont Gas Pool.
- (6) The length or width does not exceed 5,280 feet.

Gulf owns all the leasehold interest in this section and within 1500 feet of the unit well.
