Attached is a copy of Chevron's administrative application for NMOCD approval of an Unorthodox Gas Well Location and Simultaneous Dedication in the Eumont Yates 7 Rvrs Qn (Pro Gas) Pool.

Chevron has recently re-completed it's **Arnott Ramsay (NCT-D) Well No. 14** in the Eumont Yates 7 Rvrs Qn (Pro Gas) Pool. It is our desire to also simultaneously dedicate the existing 320-acre Eumont Gas Proration Unit assigned to our Arnott Ramsay (NCT-D) Well Nos. 3 and 15 (Administrative Order NSP-607 & OCD Letter Dated 1/16/79) to all three wells. As a result, the location of the Arnott Ramsay (NCT-D) Well No. 14 becomes unorthodox. The location of Well No. 14 is 1980 feet FNL and 660 feet FEL of Section 33, T-21-S, R-36-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
