Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the N/2 and SE/4 of Section 34, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the William A. Ramsay State Lease which comprises the 480 acres above described.
- (2) The William A. Ramsay State #17 located 1980 feet from the West line and 1980 feet from the North line, Section 34, T21S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed on June 30, 1954, to a total depth of 3885 feet, plugged back to 3675 feet as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.

Dear Sirs:

The Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico, is hereby notified that the 500-acre non-producing and production Unit, Tarrant Co., Texas, operating 2 1/2 and 3 1/2 of Section 34, T21S, R30E, T30S, New Mexico, and in subject thereof under the following facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil well, known as the William A. Hays well, located on the 180-acre tract described.

(2) The William A. Hays well was located 180 feet from the east line and 180 feet from the north line, Section 34, T21S, R30E, T30S, New Mexico, was completed on June 30, 1934, to a total depth of 3000 feet, plugged back to 2875 feet and a gas well in the latest gas flow. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.

(3) The proposed non-producing gas producer well will meet the requirements of Rule 5(2) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. 8-520 as follows:

(a) Continuous pressure-flow production will be maintained.

(b) The proposed well will be drilled to a single horizontal section.

(c) The average width of the proposed well may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
