DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Loaded hole with 85 barrels of oil. Spotted 10' Aquagel mud blanket on bottom, raised tubing to 3840'. Acidized thru tubing with 1000 gallons 15% NE acid by Chemical Process. Average injection rate 66 gallons per minute. Bled off 16 bbls. of oil. Displaced acid with 16 bbls. of oil. Injection time 16 minutes. Duration time 28 minutes. Well did not kick off. Swabbed all lead oil. Flowed 24 bbls. 36 gravity oil and 10 bbls of water in 11 hours.
