

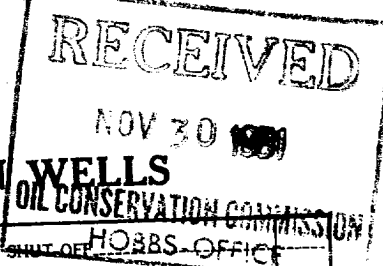

After 12 hours ran Johnston tester at 8257', opened tool for 15 minutes, found hole to be dry.
