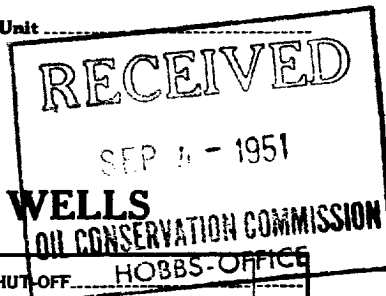

Drilled to total depth of 218', ran 9 joints of new 13-3/8" 40#, 8-40 casing - set at 238'. Cemented with 250 sacks, plug down at 9:00 A.M. September 4, 1951. Cemented to surface, circulated out 50 sacks. Will let cement set for 24 hours and test for shut off.
