The above well has reach its econimic limit of approximately one barrel of oil per day. Lightning recently struck the tank battery of this well for a total loss, and it is not econimically feasible to put the well back on production.

We propose to plug and abandon the well as follows:

1. Circulate the well bore with a gel mud.
2. Place a 25 sk cement plug across the 5½" casing shoe at 5950'
3. A 25 sk cement plug displaced at 4300'
4. A 35 sk cement plug across whatever point the 5½" casing is shot off, estimated to be approximately 3150'.
5. A 35 sk cement plug displaced at 1650'.
6. A 10 sk plug with appropriate marker at top of surface casing.

It is estimated this work will be commenced within two weeks from approval, and a subsequent report will be filed when completed, along with the location clean-up work.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
