1. Pull rods and tubing.
2. Run 4-inch tubing with packer. Sand-oil fracture perforations from 5972-6054 with 20,000 gallons of refined oil and 20,000 pounds of sand.
3. Pull 4-inch tubing and packer.
4. Run 2-inch tubing, rods, and pump. Place well back on production.
