DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to 9083' and 5-1/2" 15.5 and 17 lb. casing was cemented at 9010' with 650 sacks. The plug was down at 9:00 am 4-14-51. A temperature survey indicated the top of cement to be 4060'. Cement was allowed to set 72 hours before drilling plug. The casing was tested with 1000 psi pressure and found to be ok.

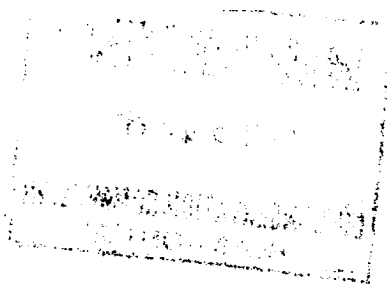
