On May 7, 1952 ran 243 joints, 7765.34' of 5-1/2" OD SRT 14# - 15 1/2# & 20#, N-80 & J-55 R-2 SS Casing with HOWCO shoe & 2 floats, with 5 B&W straight type centralizers & 20 B&W scratchers from 7774-7476'. Set & cemented w/870 sacks 4% gel slow set cement plug at 7714' Complete by HOWCO at 7:30 AM 5-7-52. Casing in hole 43 joints 1375' 20# N-80 R-2 LT&C on bottom, 47 joints 1529' 15 1/2# J-55 R-2 LT&C next. 122 joints 3839' 14# J-55 R-2 ST&C next. 31 joints 1007' 15 1/2# J-55 R-2 LT&C next. And 1 piece jt. 15' 20# N-80 LT&C on top. Gulf temperature survey found top of cement behind 5-1/2" casing at 3320' from rotary bushing.

Plug at 2956'. Maximum pressure 800#. Job complete by HOWCO at 3:00 AM 4-5-52. Gulf temperature survey found top of cement behind 8-5/8" casing at 1135'.

Propose to drill plug and test casing shut-off at 3:00 AM 4-7-52.
