Ran 74 joints 2983.75' of 9-5/8" OD 32.30 & 36# J-55 & H-40 SS Casing. Set and cemented at 2999' w/1657 sacks cement, 1557 sacks 4% Gel and 100 sacks neat on bottom. Plug at 2956'. Maximum pressure 1200#. Gulf temperature survey in 8 hrs found top cement at 235'.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 2956' to 2999', tested cement below casing shoe w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After waiting over 24 hours tested 13-3/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 280' to 299', tested cement below casing shoe w/400# pressure for 30 minutes, There was no drop in pressure.
