

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 225 Jts & 1 nipple 8288' of 5-1/2" OD 8 RT 17#, 15.50#, & 14# N-80 & J-55 B-2 & 3 ST&C & LT&C ss casing with 6 B&W centralizers & 36 B&W scratchers from 8300' to 7800'. Set & cemented at 3800' w/180 sacks 4% Gel Trinity inferno bulk cement. Plug at 8265'. Max pressure 900#.

After waiting over 36 hrs tested 5-1/2" casing w/1000# for 30 min. No drop in pressure. Went in hole and cleaned out to 8265'.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete well.
