FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On March 21, 1952, ran 203 joints, 8153.50' of 5" OD streamline 18# N-80 R-3 SS casing with 4 Baker straight type centralizers from 8150' to 7950' and 5 centralizers from 7850' to 7550'. Set and cemented at 8167' with 975 sacks 2% Gel longhorn Portland regular cement. Plug at 8083', max. pressure 2000#. Job complete by HOWCO at 11:00 a.m. 3-22-52. Gulf temperature survey top of cement at 3225'.

Propose to test 5" casing shut-off and perforate casing at 11:00 a.m. 3-24-52.
