

Reversed out 500 gallons acid wash. Total oil and acid load 194 bbls. Well started flowing without swabbing. Flowed 205 bbls. fluid out 11 1/2 BS and acid water in 2 1/2 hrs. Then flowed 346.38 bbls. oil in 12 hrs., out 16 1/2 BS. PCP 550 p.s.i. FTP 150 p.s.i.


