Ran temperature survey after 11 hours and found top of cement in annulus at 3705'. After WOC 48 hours will test casing.

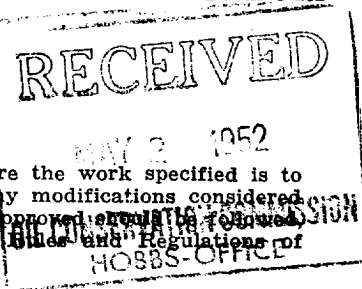
