Ran 99 joints 7 5/8" casing set at 3149' with 250 units H. Y. S. (1000 sacks) and 150 sacks next. Plug down 5-8-57. Top of cement 1425'. Casing test before drilling plug 1000-1000#, formation test after drilling plug 800-625#.
