FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was drilled to TD 6028' in the Blinebry. The Blinebry, Glorieta, and Grayburg proved to be commercially unproductive, and it was temporarily abandoned 12-8-55, at a PB 4057'.

It is now proposed to permanently plug and abandon this well in the following manner: Set cement retainer at 4010'. Squeeze perforations 4030-44' w/75 sacks. Shoot 7" casing off at 2790'. Recover 7" casing. Set 50' cement plug 2765'-2815'. Shoot 9 5/8" casing off at 845'. Pull 9 5/8" casing. Set 50' cement plug 230-280'. Set 50' cement plug, surface to 50'. Hole to be filled with 12.5# mud between all plugs. Permanent marker to be installed so as to protrude 4' above surface. Location to be restored to original condition.
