RE: Application to dually complete Famariss Petroleum
Corporation, E. C. Hill #1, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Famariss Petroleum Corporation, wishes to state the following:

- (a). That the Famariss Petroleum Corporation, E. C. Hill #1, located in Lot #10, of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, 3,300 feet from the North line and 1,730 feet from the East line of the described section was completed at a T. D. 6354'.
- (b). That the location has been moved 250 feet to the east from the center of the 40 acre unit of Lot #10, occasioned by topographical conditions and a pipe line "right-of-way". That prior to the movement of location Famariss Petroleum Corporation had notified the offset operators and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and had received permission without objection from the parties named.
- (c). The subject well has been drilled to a total depth of 6354' and 5 1/2" casing was set at 6354' cemented with 1000 sks.
- (d). The applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:
 - (1). That in perforating 5 1/2" casing in the Tubbs section for gas from the following intervals:
6105 - 6230
6278 - 6318
6345 - 6375
6374 - 6354
the well produced oil. The well tested for 4 bbls per hour and operator wishes to complete dually by producing gas in the Blinbry section.
The Blinbry section is perforated in the following intervals, I.E., 5630-5780 and 5800-5870 and tested 4100 GPP/day.

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- (e). The operator has set a production type packer at a depth of 6155' and has obtained complete segregation as determined by pressure tests.
- (f). That the perforations as herein described in the Blinbry section (5630-5780) (5800-5870) are within the vertical limits of the Blinbry pool as defined by the commission.
- (g). That the perforation as herein described in the Tubbs from (6155 - - - 634) are within the vertical limits of the Tubbs pool as defined by the commission.
- (h). That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with oil from the Tubbs pool and gas from the Blinbry pool is in the interest of conservation.
- (i). That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practicable.
- (j). In accordance with N-316 Commission Rules and Regulations the following have been notified:

Shall Oil Company
Fullerton Oil Company
Continental Oil Company
Sta. Mild Oil & Gas Company
Standard Oil Company of Texas
Atlantic Refining Company
Western Oil Fields, Inc.

Therefore, Famarriss Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.
