DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 24, 1948 at 12 midnight, 30 hours had elapsed since running 212' of 16" OD 70# LW casing in subject well, and cementing with 300 sacks, to be used as surface string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows: A pressure of 450# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and test being OK, cement plug was drilled, and a pressure of 450# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, being OK, drilling operations were resumed.
