DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The interval 6680 to 6703 was perforated with 4 shaped charges per foot and acidized with 2500 gallons 15% regular acid. Acid was overflushed with oil and swabbing and flowing test were as follows: Pulled swab one time when well kicked off and flowed. Died when 85 barrels load oil was yet to be recovered. Next swab started flowing 2" stream sulphur water.

Formation perforated was squeezed with 100 sacks Slotset cement prior to perforating at a higher level
