
Gentlemen:

August 18, 1951, a survey was made to locate your Southland Royalty Company Lease, Well No. 4, which is 660.0 feet from the south and east lines of section 4, Twp. 21 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M.

A flag was set at the corner common to sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, and at the quarter corner common to sections 3 and 4. Then by "wiggling-in" between the two flags a point on the line was established that could be seen from the above mentioned section corner. We then started our survey at the said section corner, thence north 660.0 feet, thence west 660.0 feet to the location. To check we then turned an angle of $45^{\circ}00'$ to the southeast and hit the flag at the section corner perfectly. The chained distance to the corner was 953.7 feet which is 0.4 feet long for a perfect closure.

I hereby certify that the foregoing survey was made in the field by me and that the same is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
