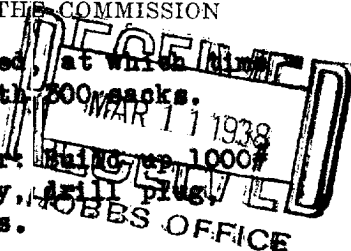

At 4:30 PM March 9, 1938, 72 hours will have elapsed, at which time we plan to test 7" OD New casing set at 3522 and cemented with 300 sacks.

We plan to conduct the test in the following manner: build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold thirty minutes. If test okay, drill plug, build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold thirty minutes.
