DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

The subject well has been shut in to conserve reservoir energy since its completion 11-30-43 as a Drinkard gas well. Present total depth 6750'.

It is proposed to plug back to approximately 6350' by setting a bridging plug at 6400' above the perforation opposite the Drinkard pay zone and placing a 50' cement cap on top of the plug. Casing will be perforated opposite the Tubbs sand approximately 6225' to 6300' and the formation acidized if necessary. The well will then be recompleted as a gas well producing from the Tubbs sand which is a recognized gas reservoir in this area.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
