Gentlemen:

Downhole commingling was authorized for your Southland Royalty "A" No. 1 located in Unit G of Section 9, T-21-S, R-37-E, under DHC Order 33. This order, as you know, authorized downhole commingling of Blinebry oil and Drinkard oil.

In December of 1972, you re-entered this well and perforated additional Blinebry intervals. As a result of this work, you have in effect created a Blinebry gas well, and therefore rescinds the commingling order.

This well is now classified as a Blinebry gas well, and you are directed to shut in the well until you have conformed with the provisions of Order No. R-1670 pertaining to the Blinebry Gas Pool.

Upon shutting in this well, it will be necessary that you isolate the Blinebry from the Drinkard so that there will be no movement of fluids from one zone to the other.

In December of 1972, you re-entered this well and perforated additional Blindery intervals. As a result of this work, you have in effect created a Blindery gas well, and therefore rescinded the commingling order.

This well is now classified as a Blindery gas well, and you are directed to shut in the well until you have conformed with the provisions of Order No. R-1670 pertaining to the Blindery Gas Pool.

Upon shutting in this well, it will be necessary that you isolate the Blindery from the Drinker so that there will be no movement of fluids from one zone to the other.
