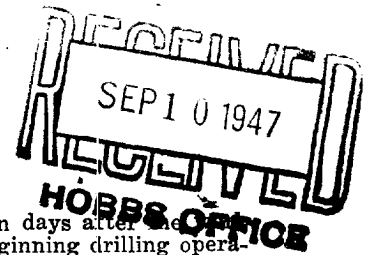

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 6th at 11:00 AM, 126 hours had elapsed since setting 8684 feet of 7" 23# J-55 and N-80 casing in subject well and cemented with 600 sacks, to be used for oil string. At the time mentioned, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for thirty minutes, and as casing tested OK, cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held thirty minutes. As this test, too, was OK, completion operations were resumed.
