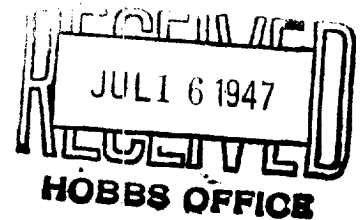

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 9:30 P.M. on July 9th, 1947, 24 hours had elapsed since running 13 3/8" O.D. new 36# Amoco casing and setting at 237 feet, cementing with 300 sacks cement, to be used as surface string. At the time mentioned, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

At pressure of 750# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and test was OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling operations were resumed.
