Gentlemen:

Order No. R-586, under Special Pool Rules and Regulations For The Tubb Gas Pool, requires that certain information be submitted on a well completed in such a manner that the producing zone of the Tubb Gas Pool and the producing zone of any other common source of supply are both open in the same well bore.

The subject well has three sets of perforations below the vertical limits of the Tubb Gas Pool and above the vertical limits of the Drinkard Oil Pool which are open to the same well bore as the producing zone of the Tubb Gas Pool. The perforations were inadvertently made during dual completion of the well in 1954. These perforations are not within the defined vertical limits of any recognized pool. However, for the Commission's intent and purpose under Order No. R-586, they may qualify as being opposite another "common source of supply" inasmuch as they are represented in the stratigraphic section of other wells in the area.

In view of the above, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company herewith submits the required information in the following attachments and petitions the Commission to assign the three sets of perforations from 6385-6405, 6455-6465 and 6485-6495 to the Tubb Gas Pool and permit continued production of the subject well as now completed from the Tubb Gas Pool and Drinkard Oil Pool, respectively:
