Gentlemen:

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company hereby files application for the dual completion of its Southland Royalty Company "A" No. 2 located in the NE/4 of Section 9, T-21-S, R-37-E, N.M.P.M.

This well is now completed in the Drinkard pay with perforations from 6595' to 6625', 6675' to 6685', and 6700' to 6730'. The applicant plans to perforate the Tubbs pay from 6200' to 6495' and dually complete using a production retainer packer for Tubbs gas and Drinkard oil production. As requested by Rule 112A, the following are attached:

- (1) A plat showing the location of all wells on applicant's lease, and all offset wells on offset leases.
- (2) A sketch showing the manner and method of applicant's proposed dual completion.

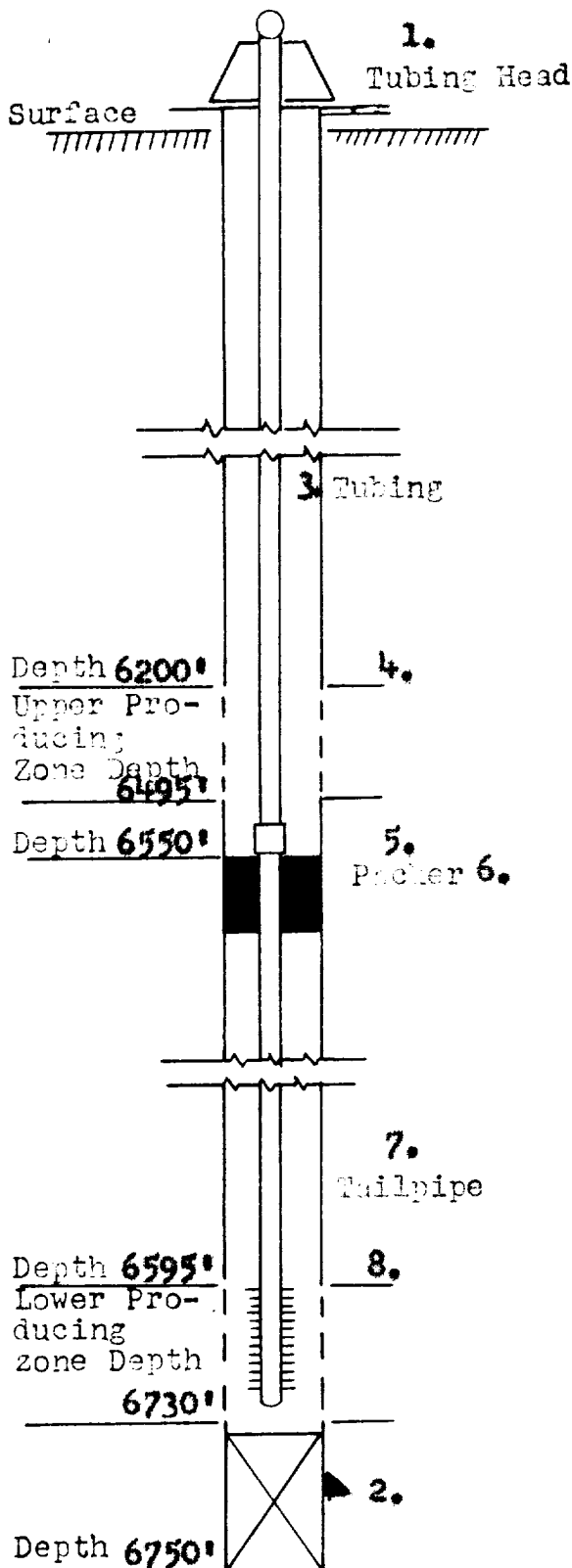

ITEM	DESCRIPTION, MAKE AND SIZE
1.	Wellhead: Nom 600 Series Type 6M Rector 4,000 pound test. Mandrel Threaded for 2-1/2" tubing.
2.	Oil String: 7", 20#, J-55 and 23# J-55, A-80, set at 6740' with 300 sacks cement.
3.	Tubing: 2-1/2", 6.5#, J-55, E.U.E. Set to packer.
4.	Upper Perforations: Tubbs Perforated from 6200' to 6495' with two jet shots per foot.
5.	Circulating Valve: Garrett Oil Tools Type A 2-1/2" Immediately above packer.
6.	Packer: Baker Retainer Production Packer Model D set at 6550'.
7.	Tailpipe: 2", 4.7#, E.U.E., J-55, Set from Packer to Approximately 6675'.
8.	Lower Perforations: Drinkard Perforated from 6595' to 6625', 6675' to 6685', and 6700' to 6730'.
