DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 21, 1947 at 12:45 AM 24 hours had elapsed since running 225' of 13-3/8" 48# new casing in subject well and cementing with 150 sacks, to be used as surface string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows: A pressure of 750# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and this test being OK cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too being OK drilling operations were resumed.
