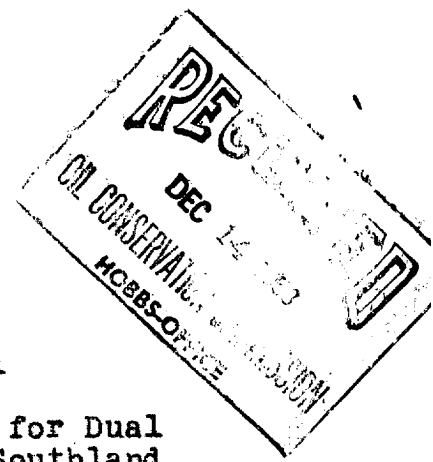

Gentlemen:

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company hereby files application for the dual completion of its Southland Royalty Company "A" No. 6, located 1980' from the north line and 660' from the east line of Section 9, T-21-S, R-37-E.

This well is now completed in the Drinkard pay at 6595' to 6635'. The applicant plans to perforate the Blinbry pay from approximately 5642' to 5802', and dually complete, using a Production Retainer Packer, for Blinbry gas and Drinkard oil production.

As required by Rule 112-A, the following are attached:

- (1) A plat showing the location of all wells on applicant's lease, and all offset wells on offset leases.
- (2) A sketch showing the manner and method of applicant's proposed dual completion.
