DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 4, 1953 ran 6880' of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing equipped with spud type scratchers and centralizers through Drinkard, Tubbs, and Blinbry landed at 6892'. Cemented with 180 sacks plus 4% gel plus 180 cu. ft. perlite followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Temperature survey indicated top of cement behind casing at 5325'. After 30 hours W. O. C. tested casing with 1075 psi for 30 min with no drop in pressure. Drilled 67' of solid cement to casing shoe and tested with 1000 psi for 30 min, and as there was no drop in pressure, completion operations were resumed.
