This well was permanently abandoned in the Ellenberger formation (7725 to 7875) by setting a bridge plug at 7650 in 5 1/2" casing and dumping 10' of cement on top of the plug. The casing and plug were pressure tested to 2500 psi for 30 minutes and found to be OK. Operations for recompletion in the Drinkard formation followed abandonment in the Ellenberger.
