Effective January 1, 1972, your Dauron No. 2 located in Unit A of Section 10, T-21-S, R-37-E is reclassified as a gas well in the Blinebry Pool. This reclassification is necessitated by the well producing with a ratio in excess of 32,000.

This well is to be shut in on January 1, and will remain shut in until you have complied with the provisions of Commission Order No. R-1670, that portion which pertains to the Blinebry Gas Pool.
