FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well is currently dually completed with oil production from the Drinkard formation and gas production from the Blinebry formation. It is proposed to temporarily abandon this well in the Drinkard zone. Permanent abandonment will be effected at such time that it is feasible to pull tubing and set a bridge plug or squeeze-cement the Drinkard zone.

The Drinkard sone has been produced by a gas lift installation utilizing 3/4" tubing within 2" tubing. The Drinkard zone is now non-productive, due to mechanical failure of the 3/4" tubing and flow values. To return this zone to production would require extensive fishing and possibly killing the Blinebry zone. The small production from the Drinkard zone does not justify the expenditure. There is no indication of communication between the two sones.

THE COMMISSION MUST BE NOTIFIED EVERY 6 MONTHS ON FORM C-103 AS TO THE WELL STATUS AND YOUR FUTURE PLANS FOR THIS WELL.
