DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 12-1/4" hole was drilled to a depth of 3000' and 3-5/8" 28.5 lb casing cemented at 2999' with 1700 sacks (1500 sacks with 4% aquagel, 200 sacks neat). The plug was pumped down at 4:20 am December 5, 1950. Cement was circulated back into the cellar. The cement was allowed to set 48 hours before drilling the plug. Prior to drilling the plug the casing was tested with 1000 psi pressure and found to be OK.
