DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A string of 431. 13-3/8" casing was cemented in a 17-1/4" hole at 195' with 200 sacks of cement. Total depth of the hole was 212'. Cement was circulated back into the cellar and allowed to set 24 hours before the plug was drilled. Hole was spudded December 4, 1950.
