DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill and dual a well at the above location with rotary tools to a depth of 6500' in the Blinebry and Tubb formations. Casing will be cemented in accordance with USGS regulations and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing program is planned: 13 3/8" OD 48# H-40 ST&C set at 350 w/250 sx, cement to return to surface; 8 5/8" OD 24# J-55 & 32# H-40 ST&C set at 3000' w/275 sx, cement to return to 2000; 5 1/2" OD 14# J-55 & 15.5# J-55 set at 6500' w/505' sx, cement to return to 2500.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
