FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Subject well is a Drinkard (Oil)-Blinebry Oil dual completion. Presently, only one zone can be produced at any given time because the well contains a single string of tbg. On 11-26-62, the Blinebry zone flowed 62 BO, no wtr, w/420 MCFG thru 20/64" choke, GOR 6774. The Drinkard zone, presently TSD, produced an average of 6 BO, 2 BW, w/119 MCFG daily, during the first 11 months of 1962. The Drinkard zone was pumped 8 hours per day twice a week.

In order to increase the producing rate from the Drinkard and produce the well from both zones simultaneously, it is proposed to: ~~cut off~~ 2-7/8" tubing at 6615' frac Drinkard through perfs 6624-6704' in 4 equal stages with 16,000 gals lease crude, 16,000 lbs sand and 800 lbs "Adomite", using 30 ball sealers between stages; install two strings of 2-1/16" tubing and place well on production.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of the above work.
