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Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of Form C-116 covering a test for reclassification from gas to oil on your State 10 Well No. 2 located in Unit E of Section 10, T-21-S, R-37-E, Blinebry Pool. This well will be reclassified as an oil well effective July 1, 1962.

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Before an oil allowable will be assigned this well, it will be necessary that you amend your existing DC Order from an oil-gas dual to an oil-oil dual. To do this will probably necessitate a hearing, since it will be an oil-oil dual with only one string of tubing. I would, therefore, suggest that you apply for this hearing at your earliest convenience, since no allowable can be assigned the well until this Order is amended.
