Subject application states that dual completion of subject well is to be accomplished by using parallel strings of $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch non-upset tubing with 1.610" ID.

Sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph II of Rule 112-A as revised by Order No. R-1214 (Case 1443) states that, "all strings of tubing used for the production of oil in the proposed dual completion will have a nominal inside diameter of not less than 1.750 inches nor greater than 2.50 inches.

Your application can not therefore, be processed administratively as you requested. If you still desire to dual complete this well, your application should be altered and put in the form of a request for hearing.
