Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests that we be granted a permit to dual complete our New Mexico State "V" Well No. 7 as a gas well from the Elinebry Gas Pool and as a gas well from the Tubb Gas Pool. In support of this application we submit the following information:

1. New Mexico State "V" Well No. 7 is located 500 feet from the south line and 1880 feet from the west line of Section 10, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. New Mexico State "V" Well No. 7 now produces as an oil well from the McKee sand in the Hare Pool.
3. We plan to set a bridge plug at approximately 6400 feet, thereby, sealing off the McKee pay.
4. We plan to perforate the Tubb gas pay between the intervals 6035-6360 feet and produce this section through the tubing.
5. A production packer will be set at approximately 6000 feet and the Elinebry gas pay will be perforated between the intervals 5640-5940 feet and produced through the casing.
6. The Elinebry and Tubb gas sections to be perforated lie within the vertical and horizontal limits of Elinebry and Tubb Gas Pools.
7. The dual completion of this well will be in the interest of conservation and the mechanics of the dual completion are feasible and practicable.
8. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail.
9. The acreage to be dedicated to the well will be 160 acres described as the SW/4 of Section 10, T-21-S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

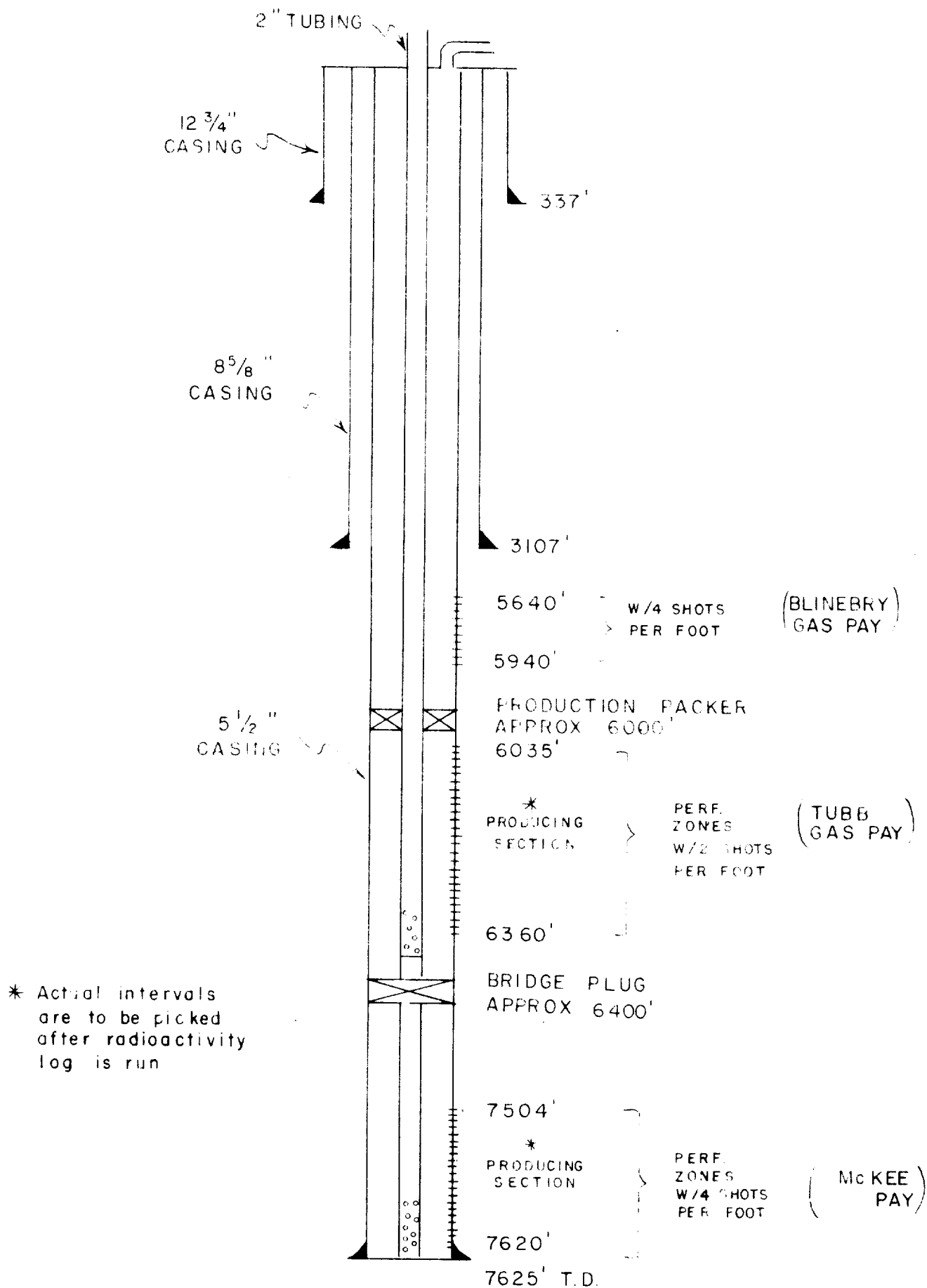

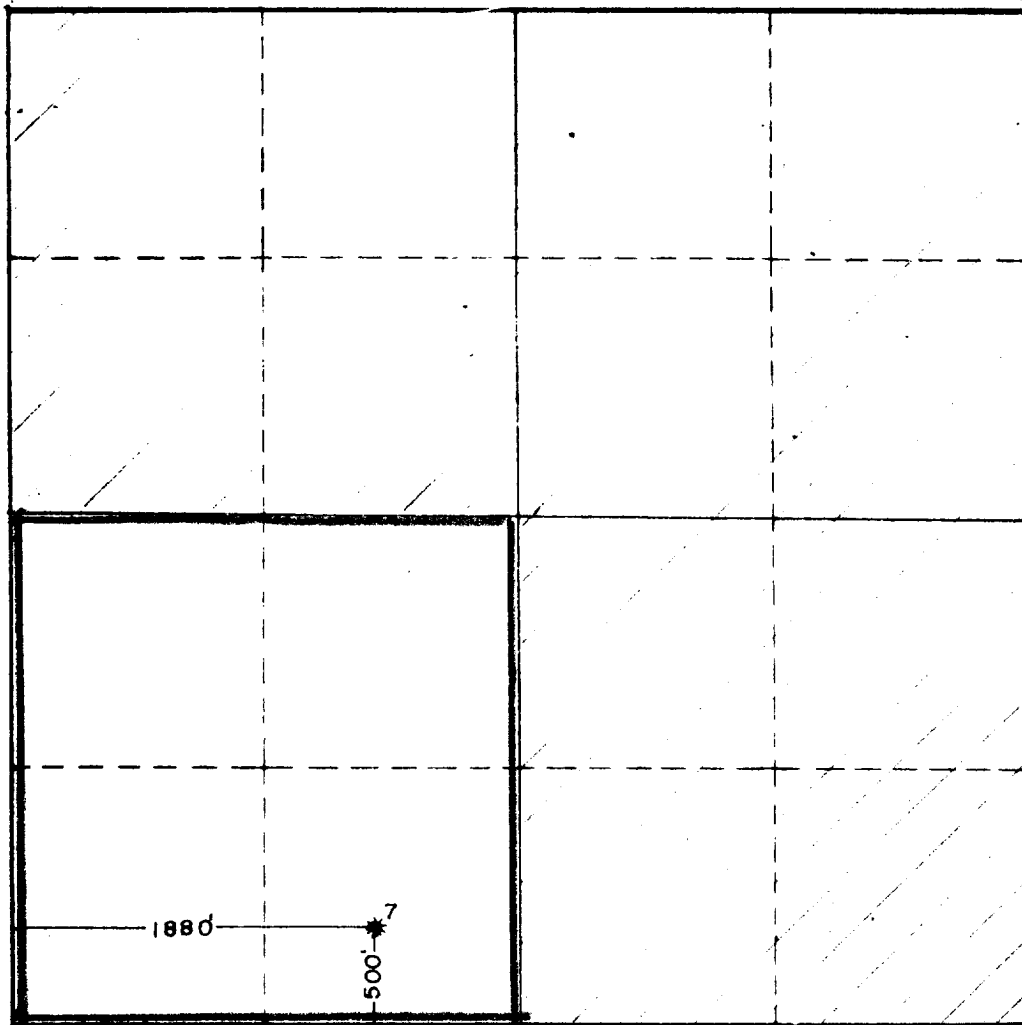
