Re: Reclassification of New Mexico State V-11, Tubb Gas Pool

Gentlemen:

Our New Mexico State V-11 Tubing located in Unit K, Section 10, T-21-S, R-37-E, is currently assigned a 120-acre Tubb Gas Pool unit consisting of the N/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SW/4. During recent testing gravity of the liquid hydrocarbons produced was found to be 42.3° API, or less than the minimum required by Commission Order R-586 for a gas well classification. It is, therefore, requested that New Mexico State V-11 Tubing be reclassified as an oil well in the Tubb Gas Pool. We will apply for a hearing before the Commission to ask exception to the gravity rule. New Mexico State V-11 Tubing was last produced on September 4, 1959, and the well will remain shut in pending outcome of the hearing.
